


## Minutes of the Meeting:

Dr.R.Satishkumar, Chairman, welcomed the gathering. Then all the points of agenda were taken up for discussion and after detailed discussion, the following resolutions were made by the members.

### Approval of Previous Minutes

The committee commenced by reviewing the minutes from the last meeting. All members unanimously endorsed the document without any amendments.

### Campus-Wide Anti-Ragging Measures

It was confirmed that anti-ragging notices and awareness posters are prominently displayed throughout the campus. Orientation sessions for incoming students will continue as part of the ongoing awareness efforts. Additionally, the committee agreed to intensify surprise inspections in hostels and common areas to deter any untoward incidents.

### Monitoring Squads and Surveillance Enhancements

The performance of anti-ragging squads and Campus Monitoring Squad were reviewed. To bolster vigilance, the committee reviewed the CCTV coverage in sensitive zones and the reinforcement of night patrols. The student reporting portal will also be upgraded to ensure swift and easy access.

### Grievance Redressal Improvements

Plans were laid out to enhance the Grievance Redressal Cell. A 24x7 helpline and a dedicated email ID will be made available to students. Grievance review meetings will be conducted to ensure timely resolution of issues.

### Student Feedback and Engagement

Student representatives expressed satisfaction with current safety measures and proposed the introduction of peer-to-peer counseling programs. The committee welcomed the suggestion and agreed to implement it in the upcoming semester.

### Regulatory Compliance

The committee reaffirmed its commitment to complying with UGC regulations and State Government directives. Annual compliance reports will be prepared and submitted to the affiliating authority as required.
