


6. Colleges will depute teachers one each for a group of 15 fresh students as counselors for interacting with them in the tutor-ward meeting.

The Committee was apprised that UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions 2009 and other instructions issued as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the Regulations of State Govt. have already been implemented. UGC and State regulations alongwith measures to be taken for curbing the menace of ragging were circulated to all the UTDs/institutes.

The Committee reviewed the measures taken during the last year and noted that:

- For the academic year 2021-22 directions regarding curbing the menace of ragging, anti-ragging committee, anti-ragging squads constituted by the head of the institution, toll free anti-ragging helpline numbers and e-mail helpline, self declaration by the student and his/her parents to the effect that the student will not indulge in ragging, and if found so, will be liable for punishment as per UGC and State regulations, have been included in the Prospectuses of various courses and also in the Hostel Rules & Regulations.
- Posters as per Clause 6(a)-(i) that "the ragging is totally prohibited in the Institution and anyone found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging, whether actively or passively, or being a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging, is liable to be punished in accordance with UGC Regulations as well as under the provisions of any penal law for the time being in force" are being got printed and will be pasted in all important places in the College Campus.
- It is applauded and mentioned in the meeting that No- Ragging Complaint was received during the last academic year.



The Committee further made the following recommendations:

1. The committee will arrange to display Flex Boards carrying anti-ragging message along with important Telephone Nos. at various prominent places on the college Campus.
2. In the meeting, it is confirmed that as per the guidelines of UGC, Anti-Ragging affidavit in online as well as the self declaration proforma from the students, who will be joining this academic year, and their parents through the class advisors of first year classes are to be carried out as done in every year. However, this is not required to be obtained from the senior students as they have already given it at the time of their admission during the last year.
3. It will be mandatory for a Principal, Chairperson, Director to include the paragraph as to whether the student has been punished for committing or abetting an act of ragging as also displayed persistent violent or aggressive behaviour or any inclination to harm others, during his/her course of study in the institution {with ref. to Clause 6.4(1)} in the character certificate to be issued from the institution last attended.
4. A meeting can be fixed in the first week of September in which the Principal, Dean (Student Affairs) and other Senior faculties of the College address to freshers and senior students regarding the ragging and its consequences.
5. UGC Toll free Anti -Ragging Help line Number 1800-180-5522 and E-mail - help line @ antiragging.net, and the Telephone numbers of University Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squads, Monitoring Cell, Nodal Officers and Counselors will be displayed.
6. Colleges will depute teachers one each for a group of 15 fresh students as counselors for interacting with them in the tutor-ward meeting.
7. Anti Ragging Squads will keep vigilance in Boys Hostels, Girls Hostels and other vulnerable areas of the University.

Objectives:



About

The college has a well structured and dynamic Examination Grievance Cell, linking students with the faculty in the continuous evaluation process and end semester examination. The function of the cell is to look into the complaints lodged by any student, and judge its merit.

Description

- The college adheres strictly to the Regulations and guidelines issued by the Academic Council while conducting internals and semester end examinations.
- Internal examination for every semester is conducted prior to the End Semester Examination.
- The eligible students are permitted to register the end semester examinations through the examination portal.
- Time table is prepared well in advance as per the Academic Schedule and communicated to the students.
- End Semester examinations conducted as per the time table and the result is published after getting approval from the Result Passing Board.

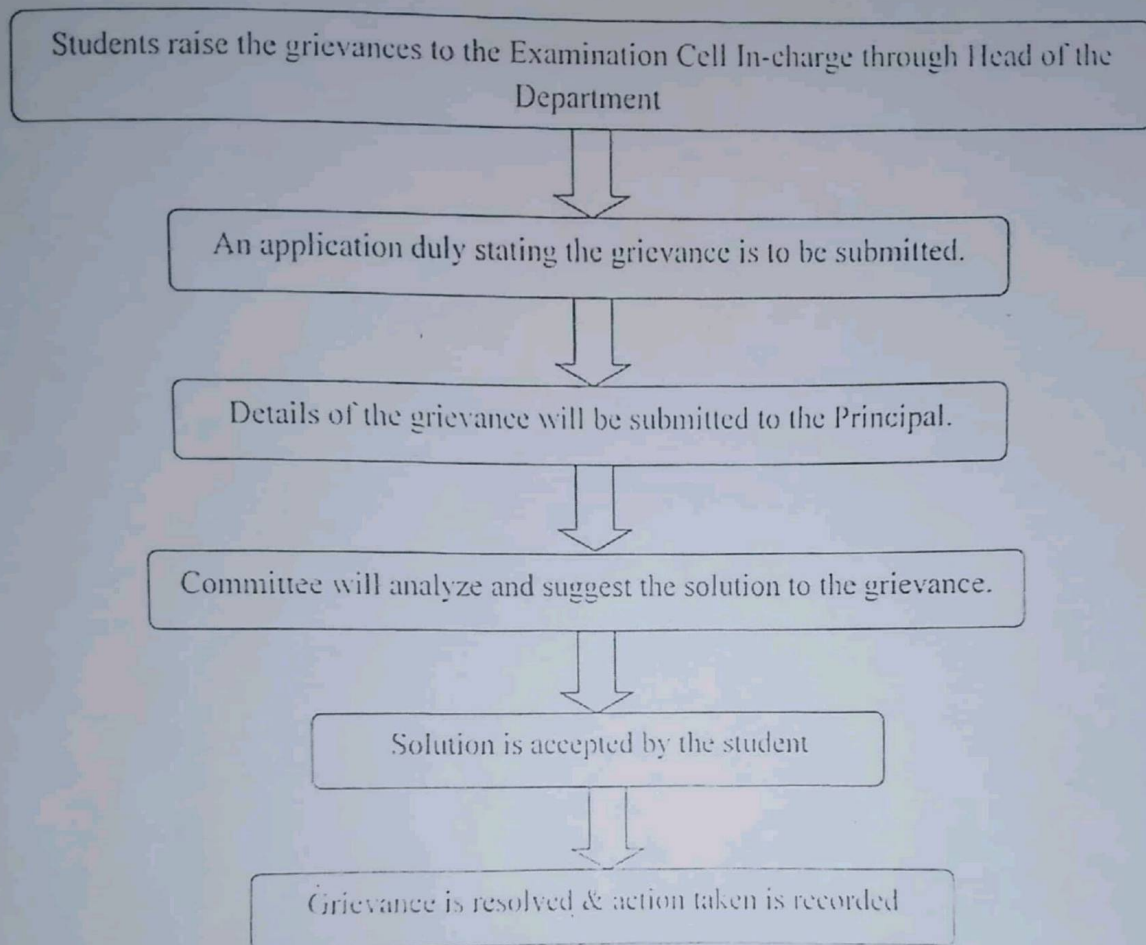
Objectives

- To solve the student's grievances related to internal and end semester examination.
- Timely conduction of retest for the needy based on the guidelines from affiliated university.
- Any grievance related to the paper like out-of-syllabus, repeated questions, improper split of marks, marks missed, wrong question number during semester exams are addressed to the Principal and Controller of Examinations immediately for necessary action.
- Review on the question papers are made by faculties to find out how tough the question papers are and the feedback is given to the department Head.
- In order to maintain transparency, students can apply for photo copy of their answer script and they may decide on re-valuation.

Procedure for grievance redressal

- Students have to approach Internal Examination In-charge or Examination Cell In-charge through the Class Advisor and Head of the Department.
- An application duly stating the grievance is to be submitted to the Examination Cell.
- Having gone through the application, the Exam Cell will submit it to the Principal.
- The Principal in consultation with the concerned faculty will examine it in detail: make a remark on the application before sending it back to the examination department.
- After taking necessary steps, students will be informed.
- The process is completely transparent.
