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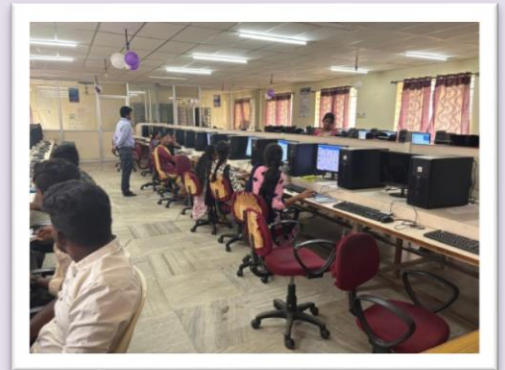


Awareness Session on the Effects of Drug Usage

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KRIAKSHETRA - Carpentry Skill Tasks

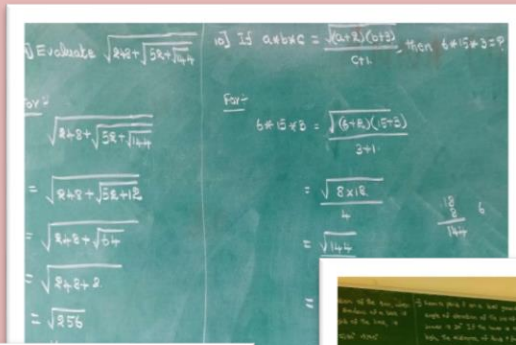
