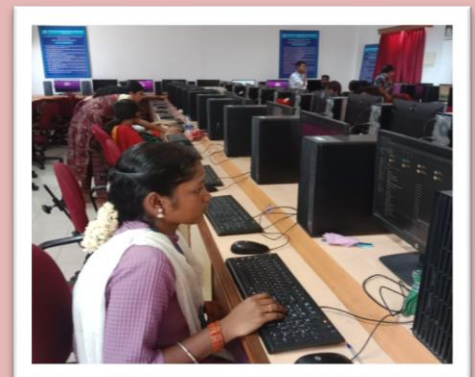


## Dr. SreeSakthivelan Motivates Final-Year Medical Students

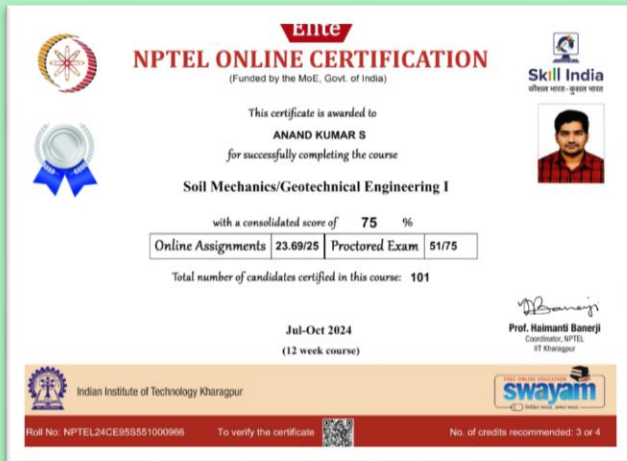
## ECE Students Gain Skills in IoT, Mobile Tech
