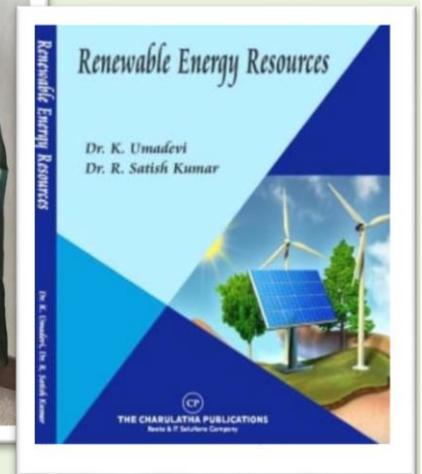


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Correspondent Expresses High Praise

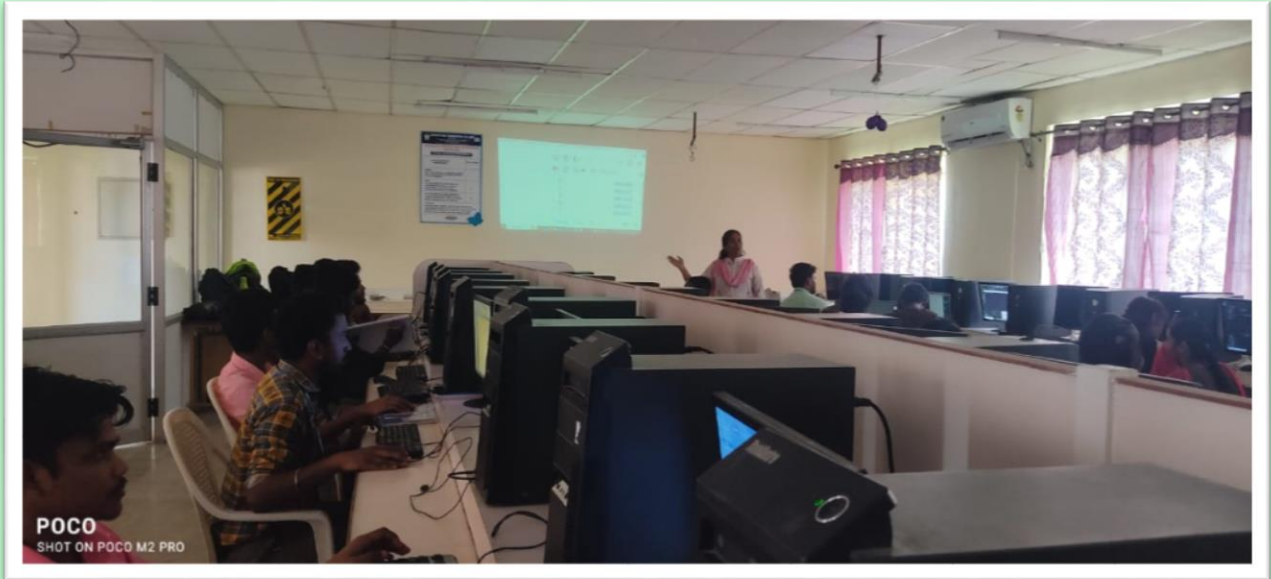
KRIAKSHETRA: Skill Tasks Completed by Second Batch Students in PLC Skills
