It has been recognized by UGC, New Delhi under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act, 1956 and also Accredited with "A" Grade by NAAC and the NAAC Accreditation has been renowned up to 31.12.2024 with the same grade point 3.06 of 4 point scale. The college is certified as ISO 9001:2015 Institution by BSCIC. This Autonomous Institution has been approved by University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education











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(AICTE), New Delhi and Anna University, Chennai for Ten years from the academic year 2019-2020 to 2028-29. The Institution has completed 20 years (2 decades) of yeomen service to the welfare of the rural society.

Since its inception, this institution has been working with the sole aim of providing quality education to the underprivileged students, who have zeal to achieve something big in their lives. Transformation and innovation are the unifying themes in all we do.

## Admission For the academic year 2022-2023

#### Commencement of Classes




This year too more than 25 papers have been published by our faculty members in various reputed National/International journals. More than 130 papers have been


## Achieving 100% Result in End Semester Examinations

Besides, our college organized 25 Guest Lecture, 15 Motivational Speech and 17 Lecture by Alumni (Interaction) to the students for their betterment.


